In which department the intern will be working

Intern will be member of working team within the project "World in Your Hands"

Job/Task Description

- 1. Monitoring Croatian society and observing issues and problems which influence development of Croatian highschool and primary schools students.
- 2. Working in high schools with students who are 16-17 years old or in primary schools with children who are 12-14 years old: organizing lessons, presenting interns country and helping students' personal development. Facilitating workshops using English.
- 3. Creating the content of workshops. The themes of the work-shops can vary from addiction to drugs and technology, violence towards the others, environment.
- 4. Interns will be working in a group of 2 or 3, delivering 5 workshops per week (2 hours each) during a period of 12 weeks. Interns will be working in more than one school.
- 5. Creating reports on social networks about internship (blog, facebook). Creating promo materials about AIESEC Split and about project (video, booklets, photos).
- 6. Getting feedback from students and principals, analysis of the workshops, doing the evaluation of the project, making suggestions on how to better the project.
- 7. Also participants of the project need to prepare a presentation about their country.

Measurable results expected from the intern:

Class Plans are delivered on time (prepared together with other interns and with the local project team) • Workshops with the proposed activities are delivered in high-quality, engaging ways • The themes of the project are understandable for the students • Interns' professional relationships with the schools is trusting and cooperative • All required reports and evaluations are delivered on time • Interns are motivated and putting daily effort in their language skills •Interns contribute to the growth and quality of the project • Interns help to communicate the project trough pictures, videos, blog posts, using social media.
